A: The Platform is designed to facilitate strong relationships between teachers and students through mentoring and ongoing feedback, fostering communication, collaboration, and critical thinking skills.

Q: How will parents monitor their child's academic progress?

A: Logging into the platform allows both teachers and parents to see exactly where students are in their learning. The blue pacing bar moves according to teacher assigned deadlines, allowing students to monitor their progress.
